Your personal property is taxed at the same rate imposed upon similar property in the tax district in which the property is located. In addition, the following penalty has been applied:

- 10% of the tax due on the value added after May 1 and on or before June 30 of the year the property was required to be reported; or
- 25% of the tax due on the value added on or after July 1 of the year the property was required to be reported.

Interest will be assessed on both the tax and the penalty from the date of delinquency of the tax, at the statutory rate of _____%, from the date the tax would have been delinquent until paid. The date of delinquency is stated on your personal property tax statement.

Instructions

Appeal Rights and Procedures. If you wish to protest the valuation of the property or penalties imposed, you must file a written protest with the county board of equalization within 30 days of the date of this notice. The action of the county board of equalization, in an appeal of the penalties imposed, is limited to correcting penalties which were wrongly imposed or incorrectly calculated. The county board of equalization has no authority to waive or reduce any penalty which was correctly imposed and calculated. If you do not file a protest in a timely manner, this personal property assessment, penalty, and interest, is final, due, and owing.
