The Property Tax Administrator, for the State of Nebraska, Ruth A. Sorensen, has announced that the examination for Nebraska County Assessor/Deputy Assessor Certification will be given on Thursday, February 3, 2011, at the State Office Building, Second Floor, Department of Revenue Training Center, 14th & M Streets, Lincoln, Nebraska, at 9:30 a.m.

This examination is given in two parts. The first session will be held from 9:30 a.m. to 12 noon, and the second session is from 1:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Individuals interested in taking this examination must submit an application, accompanied by a \$100 fee, to the Tax Commissioner no later than January 24, 2011. Applications must be sent to 301 Centennial Mall South, PO Box 98919, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509.

Certification and eligibility to hold office as a Nebraska county assessor or deputy county assessor require successful completion of this examination. Nebraska law prohibits an individual from filing for, or being appointed to the office of county assessor or serving as deputy county assessor unless he or she holds a Nebraska Assessor Certificate. In addition, without this certification, a person is not eligible to file for, or assume the office of county clerk, acting as ex-officio county assessor.
