



Notice to Nebraska Combined Sales and Use Tax Filers

After September 1, 2010, the Tax Commissioner will require, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 77-2708, that all original combined returns for Sales and Use Tax filed with the Nebraska Department of Revenue (Department) be filed electronically using the **NebFile for Business** filing program. This means that your August, 2010 Nebraska Sales and Use Tax Return, Form 10, must be filed electronically.

The Form 10 for the July 2010 tax period will be the last Form 10 mailed to combined filers. Taxpayers using the NebFile for Business program to file their Form 10 may request that a filing reminder be sent via e-mail.

Also, if you are not already making payments electronically, the Department encourages you to use our safe and secure Nebraska e-pay system to make and manage your Nebraska business tax payments.
