Before an organization may file a Nebraska Schedule II to authorize a business to sell its pickle cards, the business must have obtained or applied for a pickle card operator's license. In order to obtain a pickle card operator's license, the business must file a Nebraska Application for Pickle Card Operator, Form 50D, and submit a \$50 fee. No pickle cards may be sold by a business until it has physical possession of both a pickle card operator's license and an authorization from the organization for which it intends to sell individual pickle cards.

INSTRUCTIONS

WHO MUST FILE. Any nonprofit organization licensed to conduct a lottery by the sale of pickle cards on the premises of one or more licensed pickle card operators (Class II licensee) must complete and submit the Nebraska Schedule II in order to authorize a licensed pickle card operator to sell individual pickle cards on its behalf. Before any licensed organization can authorize a business to sell its pickle cards, that business must have obtained, from the Nebraska Department of Revenue, a pickle card operator's license.

The authorizations for pickle card operators are mailed to the licensed organization. The licensed organization is required to distribute the authorizations to the proper pickle card operators.

A pickle card operator may not sell individual pickle cards on behalf of any licensed organization until such organization has received an authorization from the

Department, entitling that pickle card operator to sell individual pickle cards on its behalf. A pickle card operator's license alone is not enough to enable a business to sell individual pickle cards. A business must have physical possession of both a pickle card operator's license and an authorization issued by the Department before it may sell pickle cards. An authorization is required for each licensed organization for which the pickle card operator intends to sell pickle cards.

WHEN AND WHERE TO FILE. All pickle card operator authorizations expire on September 30 of each year and may be renewed annually. All applications for authorization renewal should be submitted with the nonprofit organization's application for renewal of its lottery by pickle card license. New applications for authorization may be submitted at any time during the license year, October 1 through September 30.

PLEASE MAKE A COPY FOR YOUR RECORDS.

A business licensed as a pickle card operator which does not renew its retail liquor license will have its license cancelled by Charitable Gaming Services since the business no longer meets the eligibility requirements for holding the license. All pickle card operator authorizations issued to licensed nonprofit organizations for such business will also be cancelled.

The application may also be utilized during the license year to report changes in the information originally submitted or to cancel the authorization. The original copy of the application form is to be mailed to the Nebraska Department of Revenue, Charitable Gaming Services, P.O. Box 94855, Lincoln, NE 69509-4855.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

NEW. A pickle card operator may be added to those authorized to sell your organization's pickle cards by printing or typing the Nebraska identification number of the pickle card operator, the trade name and address of the pickle card operator, and placing a check mark in the "New" box.

CANCEL. To cancel an authorization for a pickle card operator, complete the Nebraska identification number of the pickle card operator, the trade name and address of the pickle card operator, and place a check mark in the "Cancel" box. The original authorization issued by

the Nebraska Department of Revenue must be returned to the Department with the cancellation request.

CHANGES. The address or trade name of a pickle card operator may be changed by indicating the Nebraska identification number, and the current trade name and address of the pickle card operator. A pickle card operator's license and the corresponding licensed organization's authorization are not transferable. A change in ownership of a business licensed as a pickle card operator requires licensing of the new ownership as a pickle card operator and a new pickle card operator authorization to be obtained by the licensed organization for that location.

AUTHORIZED SIGNATURES. The Nebraska Schedule II must be signed by an **owner, partner, member, or officer of the licensed pickle card operator**, or a person authorized by an attached power of attorney. A utilization of funds member of the licensed organization must also sign in the space provided.
