INSTRUCTIONS

WHO MUST FILE. Any individual or business that has contracted with a county, city, or village to conduct a lottery on its behalf must apply for and obtain a lottery operator license. A separate license is required for each county, city, or village on whose behalf a lottery will be conducted by the lottery operator.

WHEN AND WHERE TO FILE. All licenses issued to any lottery operator expire on May 31 of every even-numbered year and may be renewed on a biennial basis. The Nebraska Schedule I - County/City Lottery Operator Application may be submitted with the Nebraska Application for County/City Lottery, Form 50G, or submitted separately if the county, city, or village is already licensed. Applications for license renewal must be submitted to the Nebraska Department of Revenue at least 60 days prior to the expiration date of the license. License fees are due in full for the biennial licensing period. However, if a new license application is received by the Department and the license will become effective on or after June 1 of the second year of the biennial licensing period, the license fee to be remitted to the Department is one-half of the biennial fee.

The Nebraska Schedule I may also be utilized during the period covered by the license to report changes in the application information or to cancel the license. Any changes in the information originally submitted on the application must be provided to the Department within 30 days of such changes.

Mail the Nebraska Schedule I with the license fee of \$500 and attachments to the Nebraska Department of Revenue, Charitable Gaming Division, P.O. Box 94855, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4855. Please make a copy of this application for your records. Checks written to the Department of Revenue may be presented electronically.

SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS

DEFINITION. Lottery operator is any individual, sole proprietorship, limited liability company, partnership, or corporation which operates a lottery on behalf of a county, city, or village. A lottery operator is selected by the county, city, or village to conduct the lottery in its entirety on behalf of the county, city, or village. A written contract is executed which sets forth the obligations and responsibilities of both parties. A lottery operator typically has overall responsibility for the daily operation of the lottery including, but not limited to, responsibility and liability for all operational aspects of the lottery which includes daily gaming operations; purchase, repair, replacement, and maintenance of lottery equipment; purchase and maintenance of lottery supplies; compensation, staffing, and training of all employees and agents; processing and handling lottery gross proceeds; preparation of all reports required of a county, city, or village or lottery operator by the Department or any governmental entity or agency; advertising; development of official rules and regulations for play and collection of prizes and progressive game prizes; oversight of the lottery operation; and all other record keeping. Generally, individual locations within the county, city, or village which are only (1) locations where lottery tickets are sold; or (2) locations where keno is played, are not lottery operators, but are sales outlet locations.

TYPE OF OWNERSHIP. Enter the type of ownership under which your business is operated. Partnership includes all types of partnerships such as general, limited, and joint ventures. A domestic corporation is a corporation which is organized under the laws of Nebraska and has qualified to do business in this state. A foreign corporation is a corporation which is organized under the laws of another state. A domesticated corporation is a foreign corporation that is domesticated in Nebraska.

LINE 7. If your business is a corporation, limited liability company, or partnership, enter the name of the state under the laws of which the business has been formed. The Nebraska County and City Lottery Act requires a lottery operator to be a resident of Nebraska or, if a partnership, organized under the laws of Nebraska, or if a corporation, incorporated under the Nebraska Business Corporation Act, or if a limited liability company, formed under the Limited Liability Company Act. A nonprofit organization or nonprofit corporation is not eligible to obtain a lottery operator license.

LINE 8. Identify the social security number, name, address, date of birth, type of involvement (owner, member, partner, officer, debt or equity holder, or spouse), and percentage of ownership of each person who has any interest in the business to be licensed as a lottery operator.

A person is a debt holder of the partnership, limited liability company, or corporation if such person holds any mortgages, notes, bonds, convertible debentures, or other obligations, whether written or oral, issued by the partnership, limited liability company, or corporation. For purposes of this application, a debt holder does not include any financial institution organized or chartered under the laws of Nebraska, any other state, or the United States relating to banks, savings institutions, trust companies, savings and loan associations, credit unions, installment loan licensees, or similar associations organized under the laws of Nebraska and subject to supervision by the Department of Banking and Finance. A person is an equity holder of the partnership, limited liability company, or corporation if such person holds any capital stock, whether common or preferred, or any ownership interest or share issued by the partnership, limited liability company, or corporation.

LINE 9. Identify any person(s) who have an ownership interest in the license applicant not listed in line 8. Owner means a person with a right to share in the profits, losses, or liabilities of an applicant or licensee. The term includes loan guarantors who make actual debt payments for or contribute capital to a license applicant or licensee with a contingent right to share in the profits, losses, or liabilities of the operation. The term ownership interest is synonymous with owner.

LINES 10, 11a and 11b. Nebraska Revised Statutes, Section 9-1,104, requires all new applicants for a lottery operator license to be fingerprinted for criminal background investigation purposes. Please refer to the **Instructions for Completing Fingerprint Application** to determine who is subject to this requirement. Fingerprinting of a spouse will be waived if an Affidavit by Spouse for Waiver of Fingerprinting and/or Personal History Record and Background Disclosure Form for Charitable Gaming Licensees accompanies the application form. Fingerprinting may be waived for those applicants who have previously filed fingerprint cards with the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission. Insert your active liquor license number, if applicable. Each individual required to be fingerprinted must submit two fingerprint cards and the proper fees directly to the Nebraska State Patrol.

LINE 12. Each individual required to be fingerprinted must also complete and attach a **Personal History Record and Background Disclosure Form**. Completion of the **Personal History Record and Background Disclosure Form** will be waived for a spouse if an **Affidavit by Spouse for Waiver of Fingerprinting and/or Personal History Record and Background Disclosure Form for Charitable Gaming Licensees** accompanies the application form. Please note that a **Personal History Record and Background Disclosure Form** is still required even though the applicant's fingerprints were previously filed with the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

AUTHORIZED SIGNATURES. The application must be signed by a lottery operator owner, member, partner, officer or person authorized by an attached power of attorney.

COUNTY/CITY AUTHORIZATION. The application must also be signed by a member of the governing board or a governing official of the county, city or village as an indication of county/city/village approval of the applicant to conduct the lottery on its behalf.
