

How to Pay Your Balance Due

Please pay the entire amount due in one payment.

If you cannot pay the entire amount in one payment, you may choose from one of the three payment options below.

NOTE: Interest continues to accrue on the unpaid tax balance until it is fully paid.
It is YOUR responsibility to contact the Nebraska Department of Revenue (Department) to set up a payment plan.
Contact information is located on the reverse side of this notice.

Payment Options

1. Pay Entire Amount Within 90 Days.

No forms are required. Simply make four equal payments as follows:

- ✓ You can pay electronically. Go to **revenue.nebraska.gov** and click on “Make a Payment” in the For Individuals section. Click on the “Individual Income Tax” button, and then the “Make Payment” button.
- ✓ If paying by check or money order, include your Social Security number and Nebraska ID number on your payment to ensure proper processing.
- ✓ Send the remaining three payments every 30 days.

2. Pay Entire Amount in MORE Than 90 Days.

- ✓ These payments **MUST** be made by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT).
- ✓ You **MUST** contact the Department to set up this payment plan.
- ✓ You **MUST** complete a Payment and Authorization Agreement, Form 27D. Our staff will assist you with this. Go to revenue.nebraska.gov and click on “Request a Payment Plan.”

Once the Form 27D is completed, print it and send to:

- The Department will respond, and either approve or deny your payment proposal.
- If approved, payments will automatically be withdrawn from your bank account as you have scheduled.

3. Payment By Credit Card — VISA, MasterCard, Discover, or American Express are acceptable.

When paying by credit card, you **MUST** pay the entire balance due in one payment.

- ✓ These secure payments are made through Official Payments. You may:
 - Call our Department at 800-742-7474;
 - Contact Official Payments directly at its toll-free number, 800-272-9829; or
 - Make payments online at officialpayments.com.
- ✓ If scheduling your payment by phone, you will be asked for your **JURISDICTION CODE**. Your **Jurisdiction Code is 3700**.
- A **convenience fee** of 2.49% (\$1 dollar minimum) of the tax payment will be charged to your credit card. This fee is paid to Official Payments and will appear on your credit card statement separately from the tax payment.
- You will be told the amount of this fee during the transaction with Official Payments, and you will have the option of canceling the transaction at that time.

Ways to Avoid a Balance Due in the Future

1. Make sure a sufficient amount of income tax is being withheld from your paycheck. Contact your employer to make the necessary changes to your Form W-4.
2. If you make **estimated income tax payments**, review your tax situation to make sure you are paying sufficient amounts.

By following these suggestions, you will avoid costly penalties and interest.
